 23 Feb. '45 the 29th Div. pushed
 across the Roer River on the
 bridges constructed by the 1104
 Group to start the Ninth
 Army's offensive into the heart
 of Germany.



In the Hurtgen forest, during the
 Ardennes Breakthrough, the Group
 erected a total of 67,700 yards of
 Barbed Wire Obstacles, constructed
 many other Barriers and Road Blocks,
 and dug many Gun positions.

Acting as Infantry again the Group
 pushed at the Western approaches to
 Aachen while the First and Thirtieth
 Divisions moved into the city from the
 other sides.
