

SUBJECT: Monthly Journal.

- TO: Commanding Officer, 540th Engineer Regiment, A.P.O. #464.
 - 1. Journal April 1944 submitted herewith.
 - a. Beach Operation (X-Ray Beach):- No supplies unloaded. Telephone watch maintained twenty-four hours daily.
 - b. Use of Equipment: Bulldozers used at the Ordnance and Quarter-master dumps to build bunkers for ammunition and fire walls for gasoline. Bunkers were also constructed at the Airport.
 - c. Road Maintenance and construction:— Road not from F 890179 to RJ 942169 to RJ 941154 to Fork F 900178 maintained for Class 40, two-way, all-weather traffic. New roads constructed at ammunition, ration and CWS dumps and an exit road to the East from 5th Army Headquarters.
 - d. Construction of "Hards": Construction of "Hards" on X-Ray-RED and YELLOW Beaches continued.
 - e. Mine Field clearing: Rechecking and clearing of YELLOW Beach continued. Road cleared thru 52nd DUKW Battalion area.
 - f. Unloading of YALE: Unloading of cargo from destroyed LIBERTY Ship YALE off GREEN Beach completed.
 - g. <u>City Sanitation:</u>— The city of ANZIO inspected for fly and mosquito breeding materials; buildings cleared of all such materials.
 - h. Italian Supervising: Interpretors assigned to the ration dump to supervise Italian labor in clearing ration dump of refuse.
 - i. Relocation of 5th Army water point: 5th Army water point was more advantageously located.
 - j. Fly-proofing: Kitchen, mess and latrines screened at 5th Army Headquarters.
 - k. Construction:- Pipes laid to divert effluent, shelters built at Quartermaster laundry. A cement floor 15' x 60' constructed at Quartermaster Bakery. Incinerator constructed at ANZIO.
