The section did their regular routine job of maintaining liaison with higher headquarters, publishing a news sheet and distributing it to the regiment and attached units, and keeping up to date situation maps of all fronts.

The section photographer took, developed, and printed pictures of events, projects, and damage through enemy action throughout the month. The section constructed and is maintaining a map and war room for the port headquarters.

In addition to their regular duties the section did numerous jobs for other sections of the regiment and other organizations. The section drew and reproduced charts for a mosquito control project on the Beachhead, made booklets and maps showing harbor information for the Royal Navy and the American Navy, drew and reproduced demolitions charts for the first battalion 540th Engineers, drew and reproduced Mother's Day greetings and calendars for the regiment and attached units, reproduced forms for 5th Army Transportation and port headquarters, and reproduced the sheets for a new Signal SOP for shore operations for the 74th Signal Co.

The section draftsman painted signs for the regimental headquarters and port headquarters in the absence of the regimental sign painter, and made signs and plaques for the 5th Army Sanitation School.
