1. Following is a condensation of ACTIVITY JOURNAL, this Headquarters, for the month of April, 1944:

April 1-30, 1944: ANZIO, Italy - Continued administration, improvement, maintenance and coordination of Harbor of Anzio, including X-Ray and Yellow Beaches. Regimental Staff continued functions as Army Engineer Advance C.P., Anzio area.

Furnished fire and rescue crash patrols, Anzio area. Continued maintenance and improvement of supply routes, filling bomb craters and pot-holes, including in connection therewith the preparation, mix, and issue of cold-patch and crush rock. Miscellaneous tunnel work and construction of tunnel office sections, Fifth Army Advance C.P. tunnel. Dug gun emplacements and ammunition pits.

Anti-malaria and sanitation program stressed, including regular medical inspections, furnishing of anti-malaria detail for town of ANZIO, issuance of directives, preparation of charts, and attendance at Sanitation School. Operated improvised truck street sprinkler and constructed incinerator in conjunction with Anzio sanitation program.
