  Lt. Hudson, Company "E", awarded the Bronze Star Medal.
- 15 August 1944: Battalion arrived at shores of France at 0630B hours. Remained off shore until 1430B hours when an attempt was made to land on Red Beach (Beach 264A) but could not land due to beach obstacles and shelling. Isaded on Green Beach, Agay, France at approx. 1620B hours to 1745B hours. Moved to Yellow Beach for beach operations. At approx. 1800B hours an "F" Company D-7 dozer was damaged by a mine when it attempted to clear beach to facilitate unloading of craft. Pvt. Fritchman, Co. "D", WIA, Pvt. Stecher, Co. "D", KIA, S/Sgt. Ross, Med. Det., WIA, Tec 4 Sholes and Pvt. Chatman of Co. "E", WIA, in enemy mine field at approx. 2130B hours, in vicinity of Yellow Beach. Air-raid at approx. 2055B hours.
- 16 August 1944: Agay, France. Company "D". Operation of water point. Issued 7.390 gallons of water. Pioneer Group cleared 11 mines from two (2) ICT landing roads for ICT's on Yellow Beach. Laid four (4) rolls of Summerfelt matting. Fenced road. On one (1) ICT landing used 30 bangalores to destroy an estimated 20 enemy mines. Used 12 packs of tetratol for clearing landing for Navy craft ICT's. Destroyed 20 mines. Used five (5) packs of tetratol clearing landing

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for ICM's and clearing road exits. Destroyed 30 mines. Laid 12 rolls of Summerfelt matting. Operated beach from OSOOB-1900B hours. Unloaded 640½ tons of supplies. Company "E", Agay, France. Setting up bivouac area. Laid Summerfelt matting on Yellow Beach to facilitate unloading of craft. Company "F", Agay, France. Setting up bicouac area. Laid Summerfelt matting on Yellow Beach to facilitate unloading of craft. Air-raid at approx. 2050B hours.

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17 August 1944: Company "D", Agay, France. Air-raid at approx. 2050B hours.

18 August 1944: Company "D", Agay, France. Operation of water point. Issued 15,025 gallons of water. Operation of Yellow Beach. Unloaded: Class I 12tons, Class II & IV 75 tons, Class III 223 tons, and Class V 160 tons. Total tonnage 470 tons. Company "E", Agay, France. Operation of Yellow Beach. Unloaded 1075 tons of supplies. Company "F", Agay France. Reconstruction of port installations of San Raphael. KIA by result of enemy mines at approx. 1045B hours, at Port of San Raphael. PFC Hughes, PVT. Kranz, and Pvt. Lawson of Company "F". WIA by result of enemy mines at approx. 1045B hours at Port of San Raphael: Pvt. Kriegal, Pvt. Pomeroy, Pvt. Richman, Pvt. Crosby, Pvt. Motley and Sgt. Turner. Air-raid 2100B hours. Pfc DeMarc, Co. "F" KIA by enemy mine at approx. 1045 B. hours, at Port of San Raphael, France.

19 August 1944: Company "D", Agay, France. Operation of water point. Issued 15,220 gallons of water. Company "E", Agay, France. Operation of Yellow Beach. Unloaded 345 tons of supplies. Company "F", Agay, France. Reconstruction of port installations in Port of San Raphael. Air-raid at approx. 2045B hours.

20 August 1944: Battalion Headquarters, Companies "D", "E", and "F" and Medical Detachment moved from old bivouac area, Agay, France, to new bivouac area, approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Comapny "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Setting up new water point. Operation of Port of San Raphael, France. Unloaded: 105 tons of Class II & IV tons and 112 tons of Class V. Total tonnage 220 tons. Company "E", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of Port of San Raphael, France. Unloaded 300 tons of supplies. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Reconstruction of port installations of Port of San Raphael. Air-raid at approx. 2050B hours.

21 August 1944: Comapny "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Completed construction of Battalion Showers. Operation of water point. Issued 2840 gallons of water. Operation of Port of San Raphael. Unloaded: 69 tons of

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Tlass I, 72 tons of Class II & IV, total tonnage 141 tons of supplies. Care and cleaning of equipment. Company "E", Approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of Port of San Raphael. No supplies unloaded. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Reconstruction of port installation in Port of San Raphael, France.

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22 August 1944: Company "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of water point. Issued 3,050 gallons of water. Operation of port of San Raphael. Unloaded 73½ tons of Class II and IV supplies. WP 51-10, Swept port roads. Opened Ave. Amiral from Harbor Road to Road Block at Felix Martin St., in port of San Raphael. Care and Cleaning of equipment. Company "E2, approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Working at harbor. String concertina at Ration Dump, completed around CM Dump Class I & II. Using cranes at harbor. Hauling cargo from harbor. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael. WP SR-11, removing water from basement of Port CP. Reconstruction of port installation in port of San Raphael.

23 August 1944: Company "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of water point. Issued 29,521 gallons of water. Operation of port of San Raphael. Unloaded: 126 tons of Class III and 271 tons of Class V. Total tonnage 397 tons. Company "E", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Checking at Railhead. Checking for mines at Class V Dump and Airport. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Removing water from basement of Port CP. WP SR-10, Widening of intersection. Reonstruction of port of San Raphael; setting of cribbing and driving piles. Clearing of mines in theatre of San Raphael.

24 August 1944: Company "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of water point. Issued 24,282 gallons of water. Operation of the Port of San Raphael. Unloaded: 23 tons of Class I, 41 tons of Class II & IV, 303½ tons of Class III, and 354 tons of Class V. Total tonnage 72½ tons. Company "E", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael. Loading rations at Railhead. WP SR-15, Making repairs at airport for storage of supplies. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. WP SR-10, Clearing of rubble. Clearing of port area; cribbing of jetty, driving piles, sweeping streets and blasting of road blocks.

25 August 1944: Company "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of water point. Issued 30,205 gallons of water. Operation of port of San Raphael. Unloaded: 36½ tons of Class I, 79½ tons of Class II and IV, 263½ tons of Class III, and 191 tons of Class V. Total tonnage 570½ tons. Company "E", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Loading trains at Frejus railhead. WP SR-15, Filling holes with rubble and completed clearing. WP SR-19, Removing wire from poles. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Widening of corner at intersection, WP SR-10. WP SR-16, Mine Details. WP SR-22, Mine Detail completed. Clearing of Fort Area; clearing of rubble and rubbish, completed cribbing, driving piles, drilling holes for blasting. Sgt. Bourgeois, Company "E", KIA as a result of enemy mines while clearing a mine field on road to Boulouris, at approx. 0930B hours.

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26 August 1944: Company "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of water point. Issued 28,600 gallons of water. Operation of port of San Raphael. Unloaded: 50 tons of Class III, 64 tons of Class IV, and 11 tons of Class V. Total tonnage 125 tons of supplies. Company "E", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Loading trains at Railhead. WP SR-21, Completed POW enclosure. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. WP SR-10, Widening of intersection. WP SR-25, Repairing so surface at entrance #1 to Port Area, 100% complete. WP SR-29, Reconnaissance of Radar Station at Green Beach. Glearing of Port Area; driving piles, policing of timbers, hauling of crushed rock and clearing of parking area.

27 August 1944: Company "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of water point. Issued 32,910 gallons of water. Operation of Port of San Raphael. Unloaded: 42 tons of Class I, 115 tons of Class II & IV. 400 tons of Class V. Sotal tonnage 560 tons. Company "E", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Loading cars at Railhead. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. WP SR-10, Widening of intersection. Clearing of Port Area; hauling crushed rock and drilling pill-box.

28 August 1944: Company "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of water point. Issued 31,580 gallons of water. Operation of Port of San Raphael. Unloaded: 9 tons of Class I, 241 tons of Class II & IV, 51 tons of Class III, and 488 tons of Class V. Total tonnage 789 tons of supplies. Company "B", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Loading trains at Railhead. WP SR-33, Clearing loading space at the Railhead. Started removal of coal scuttles and railroad rails and poles. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. WP SR-10, Widening of intersection. WP SR-34, Repaired broken water main at Frejus, job 100% complete. WP SR-36, Repaired road in front of Excelsior Hotel, job 100% complete. Clearing of Port Area in San Raphael; hauled crushed rock and constructed decking on jetty, filling in trenches.

29 August 1944: Company "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of water point. Issued 34,025 gallons of water. Operation of Port of San Raphael. Unloaded; 45½ tons of Class I, 216½ tons of Class II & IV, 57½ tons of Class III, 374 tons of Class V. Total tonage 693½ tons of supplies. Company "B", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Loading cars at Railhead. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. WP SR-10, Widening of intersection, job 50% complete. WP SR-39, Repaired road La Cigale Hotel, job 100% complete. Clearing of cement bags and equipment from Railhead area. Clearing of Port Area; finishing of decking on jetty, job 90% complete.

30 August 1944: Company "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of water point. Issued 24,335 gallons of water. Operation of Port of San Raphael. Unloaded: 42 tons of Class II & IVW and 367 tons of Class V. Total tonnage 409 tons of supplies. Company "E", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Loading cars at Railhead. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Hauling cement from Railhead to Engineer Dump.

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Hauling rock and pouring cement on jetty, job 100% complete. Erected two (2) five (5) prop bents; hauled rock, cement and sand, erected braces.

January 1944: Company "D", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Operation of water point. Issued 32,670 gallons of water. Operation of Port of San Raphael, France. Unloaded 21 tons of Class I, 123 tons of Class II & IV, and 338 tons of Class V. Tomal tonnage 482 tons of supplies. Company "E", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. Loading cars at Railheed. WP SR-41, Fire control measures made available at all dumps: 35 shovels to gas dump, 4 loads of sand and 8 shovels to dump #13, 20 shovels to dump #4, 6 water type extinguishers to Signal dump, 10 loads of sand to drum dump on Red Beach. Company "F", approx. one (1) mile north of San Raphael, France. WP SR-40, Construction of one-way bridge in Cannes; pouring of cement, placing of shims on caps and policing of material for fill and rail. WP SR-45, Widening of intersection, job 100% complete. Removing cement from Railhead area to Engineer Dump, job 100% complete.
