ACTIVITY JOURNAL, DECEMBER, 1943

- Dec. 1 10, 1943. VICINITY OF FRANCOLISE, ITALY: Usual regimental section duties, personnel correspondence processed, preparing and processing daily morning reports, G-l daily and weekly reports, daily ration reports. Officers' November 1943 Payroll Vouchers totalling approximately \$4,000.00 paid. Enlisted Men's November 1943 payroll amounting to approximately \$70,000.00 paid. Processed personnel applications for transmittal of funds via PTA plan. Total amount of funds thus transferred approximately \$23,500.00. M/Sgt Eugene A. Ervin, H&S Co. appointed Warrant Officer (jg) involving no change in assignment. Details of honorable discharge of M/Sgt Ervin completed and filed and miscellaneous papers required in appointment as Warrant Officer completed and filed.
- Dec. 11 18, 1943. VICINITY OF FRANCOLISE, ITALY: Usual regimental personnel section duties, personnel correspondence processed, preparing and processing daily morning reports, G-1 daily and weekly report and daily ration reports. Enlisted Men's payroll and Officers' Pay Vouchers for month of December 1943 prepared, signatures obtained and submitted to 6th Port Finance Officer for payment.
- Dec. 19, 1943

 VICINITY OF FRANCOLISE, ITALY: Captain Thomas C. Arminski (MC)

 transferred to and joined this regiment from Personnel Center

 No. 6 and was assigned to Medical Detachment. Sergeant John

 M. Kapetanich, Co. "D", fatally injured when struck in head

 by rock during quarry blasting creation (Non-Battle Casualty).

 Investigation completed and Sergeant Kapetanich was determined
 to be in Line of Duty status.
- Dec. 20, 1943.

 VICINITY OF FRANCOLISE, ITALY: Captain John F. Sass, Regimental Adjutant, left regiment as part of October 1943 increment of personnel rotated to U.S. Captain James W. Robeysek designated Regimental Adjutant and 1st Lt. Timothy F. Clifford transferred from Company "D" to Regimental Hq. with duties as Personnel Adjutant.
- Dec. 21 31,1943. VICINITY OF FRANCOLISE, ITALY: Usual regimental personnel section duties, personnel correspondence processed, preparing and processing daily morning reports, G-1 daily and weekly reports and daily ration reports. Arrangements completed with 5th Army QM for regimental PX supplies for 2-week period. PX supplies distributed and accounting therefor maintained.
- GENERAL: No casualties due to Enemy Action during month.
