

1. Journal January 44, submitted herewith.
2. Movement of Troops:- Battalion moved to vicinity of POSTUOLI, Italy on 2 January 44.
3. Training of Troops:- Battalion took part in training program with 3rd Division and Sixth Corps as well as following its own training schedule.
4. Preparation of Amphibious Equipment:- The Battalion drew amphibious equipment that it was short and prepared other equipment for an amphibious movement.
5. Amphibious Movement:- The Battalion landed and acted as Shore Engineers, operating Green and Red I beaches from 22 January 44. At the end of the month the Battalion was unloading an average of better than 1000 tons a day of bulk supplies across the beach.
