Subject: Monthly Activity Journal - March, 1944.

To : Commanding General FIFTH ARMY APO #464 U.S. Army.

1. Following is a condensation of Activity Journal, this Headquarters, for the month of March 1944:

March 1 - 31, 1944: ANZIO, Italy - Continued administration, operation, and coordination of activities of Harbor of ANZIO and X-Ray Beach. Regimental Staff continued functions as Army Engineer Advance C.P. Continued beach security defense and furnished fire patrol for towns of ANZIO and NETTUNO. Operated rescue and road patrols and continued maintenance and improvement of supply routes. During the latter part of the month, the Regiment, thru its Surgeon acting as Port Surgeon together with Assistant S-3 promulgated comprehensive Sanitation and Malaria Control regulations in the Port Area and adjacent beaches. Initial phases of field survey and inspection program begun.
