- May 1-3, 1944 AMEIC, ITALY. Usual regimental personnel section duties, personnel correspondence, and processing daily morning reports and daily ration strength. Allied Men's payroll and Officers' pay vouchers for month of April paid, payroll for 10th Fort Hq. Det. completed and paid. Captain O'Brien designated Ass't 1-3. Captain Ferry designated Executive Officer 2nd Battalion vice Captain O'Brien relieved. Captain Brown designated Commanding Officer of Co. "D" vice Captain Ferry relieved.
- May 4-8, 1944 AMEIC, ITALY. Usual regimental personnel section duties, personnel correspondence, and processing daily morning reports and daily ration strength. Prepared S/R's and Allied papers for 6 men returning to the States on "Rotation". Captain Clifford placed on D1 to Naples for purpose of checking hospitalized personnel. Supplemental payroll for 5 men of M. & I. Co. on D1 in Naples prepared and submitted. Started payroll for month of May.
- May 9-16, 1944 AMEIC, ITALY. Usual regimental personnel section duties, personnel correspondence, and processing daily morning reports and daily ration strength. Payroll completed and submitted to Finance. Captain Clifford from D1 to Naples to duty. Lt. Colonel Monnier transferred to 120th Engineers per S/C 104 Hq. IV Corps. Major Knapp assuming command of 2nd Battalion. Personnel Office moved to new location.
- May 17-24, 1944 AMEIC, ITALY. Usual regimental personnel section duties, personnel correspondence, and processing daily morning reports and daily ration strength. Reading of the Articles of War and Sex Morality course entered on S/Rs. Prepared list of Promotions, Citations, and Commendations of the Regiment while in the beachhead for the Public Relation Office,
