

Subject: Monthly Activity Journal - May, 1944.

e Commanding General, MIGINEER HQ, FIFTH ARMY, APO #464, U.S.Army

1. Following a condensation of ACTIVITY JOURNAL, this Headquarters, for the month of May, 1944:

1944: ANZIO, Italy - Continued supervisory administration and coordination of Port of ARZIO. Regimental Staff continued functions as Army Engineer Advance CP (Port of ANZIO).

Furnished fire and resous erach patrols ANZIO area. Continued furnishing of usual and varied Engineer corvices, ANEIO area: deser work, maintenance of main and secondary routes, including operation of cold-patch plant, proparation, mix and laying of ever 8,000 cu.yds "black top", dug revelments for hospitals and other service brenches, operation of water points and furnishing of water, complied with requests of other service brenches for sign work.

Constructed LCT hards and clossed small graft harbor of debris and damaged craft, and harbor put in use; completed harbor soundings map; construction of incinerator completed; ice plant and verious ico-making machines repaired and set up for operation; underground survey of sever lines, water mains, and conduits of town of AMZIO completed and report submitted; 8,000 FW stockade constructed.

Minefield at LITTORIA and LAFRISIA oleared of 780 Italian box mines and 250 Hol/S mines, including checking of buildings for booby-traps. .

Anti-malaria and sanitation program emphasized, areas drained, filled in, sprayed and inspected. Detail and equipment furnished for agrinkling of main streets of ANZIO.
