The section published a daily news sheet and distributed it to all the com-panies of the regiment and attached units. The section photographer took pictures of read jobs, ship unloading, dock repairs, and all other work projects of the regiment and made prints for higher headquarters and the regimental album.

The section kept a detailed sitiation map of the Italian front in the office and another in the regimental headquarters for the benefit of everyone interested.

They also kept maps of theRussian front and the Pacific Theater.

At the beginning of the big drive on the Italian front the section drew maps covering the advances of the Allies and distributed them to all the companies of the regiment in order that the men might follow the advances more closely.

On the 24th of the month the S-2 officer was made Orientation Officer for the regiment. From that date on the section gave daily orientation lectures

On several occasions the section went to different sectors of the front covering all fronts. for the purpose of Road Reconnaissance.
