- TO : Commanding Officer, 840th Engineer Regiment, A.P.O. #464.
 - 1. Journal May 1944 submitted herewith.
 - a. Beach Operation (X-Ray Beach): No supplies unleaded. Telephone watch maintained twenty-four hours daily.
 - b. Use of Equipment: Bulldesers used at the Ordnance and Quarternaster dumps; 52nd DUKW Company; Ecspitals; Sterligation units; Bakery; to construct ounkers and revetments for ammunition and equipment; also leveling of areas.
 - c. Road Maintenance and Construction: Road met from 388178 to 005183; 900178 to 972137 crossreads 941154 to 942169; 972137 to 959165 maintained for Class 40, two-way, all-weather traffic. Continued filling pot holes with tarme; (using 525 leads); shoulders and ditches improved; culverts constructed. Continued sprinkling of X-Ray road met.
 - d. Construction of "Hards": Construction of "Hards" on X-Ray, RED and YELLOW Boaches completed.
 - E. Mine Field Clearing: Removed mines firlds near LITTORIA and IA FERRIA and 51st Signal Commany, (approx. 1000 mines removed) 071194 to 065184 to 086170 to 085187, 008245 to 008242 to 016240 to 015245, 116267. Buildings checked for booby traps; paths cleared to trapped tanks for the 45th Ordnance. In all, 780 Italian Box mines and 230 Heltz Box mines were lifted.
 - f. Construction: Concrete floor 1753 feet square and 4 Inches thick laid for bakery unit. Plumbing installed at bakery and for hespital sterilization Unit. Worked on advance C.P. for 5th Army Headquarters. Assisted installation of 16th Evac Mospital and 18th Field Hospital by grading areas, building reads and revetting tents. Repaired existing ice plant at ANZIO. Three (3) Red Cross Markers 200 feet square were constructed of stone in Hospital Zomes.

E. Beach Protection: - Patroled Beach F912095 to G095095, F912178 to GC80095, from May 30 on.

h. Harber Clearance: - Small beat harber sounded, about 15 wrecked craft removed. Underwater Survey made of remaining wrecked ships.

i. Mosquito Control: - Battalion areas drained, filled and sprayed to control malaria.

j. Operate Rock Quarry: - Operated Rock Quarry at N935168 between 24 May - 26 May. Produced 60 loads secondary rock, 65 loads of primary rock, 96 loads big rock and 101 loads of asphalt mix.

k. Operate Rifle Range Renge and Beacht - Operated Rifle range and beach for VI Corps from 24 May to 30 May.
