- 1. The following is a report of accomplished work for the month of May:
- (a) One LOT hard was constructed on Yellow boach at Ansic Port capable of handling six LCTs at a time.

(b) One LOT hard was constructed on Red boach South of Nettune capable of handling three LCTs.

(c) The small craft harber at Ansie was cleared of sunken ships and debris and put into use.

(d) Billdezers operated continuously at ASFs and Gaseline dumps constructing bunker protection.

(e) Road maintenance on all main and secondary possis in vicinity of Ansie beachhead was continuous all during the mouth.

(f) Harbor soundings were made and recorded on map for harbor of Ansie.

(g) Construction of 5th Army CP at Ansie completed.
(h) Burker was constructed for all Dukes of 62ud QH Btm.

(i) Revetments and digging in of 15th Evac Hespital was accomplished.
(j) Construction of Incinerator for Ansie was completed.

(k) Red Cress merkors were constructed in Hospital area. (1) Civilian Ico-plant repaired and set up for operation in Ansio.

(m) Ico making machine constructed and put in operation at Hospital area.

(n) Revetments constructed at 5205 QM.

o) Revotments comstructed at 112 Ordnance for Ordnance equipment.

(p) Underground survey of sever lines, water mains, and conduits of town of Ansie was made and report submitted.

(q) Ice making machine assembled, installed, and serviced for Ration dump.

(r) Approximate one-hundred gallens of water was distilled for CHS daily.

(s) Stockade constructed for FW, eight-thousand man capacity. (t) Made reads, ditches, and revetted tents for installation of 16th Evac Hospital.

(u) Minefield at Littoria cleared of 580 Italian box-mines and 230 Hol/S mines.

(v) 3,154 cu. yards of "Black Top" crushed, mixed, and placed on read surface of beachhead.

(w) Operated 5th Army water point and issued 575,982 gallens of water for the month.
