SUBJECT: MONTHLY JOURNAL FOR MAY.

TO : COMMANDING OFFICER, 540TH ENGINEER REGIMENT, A.P.O. # 464.

1. The following is a report of accomplished work for the month of May:

- (a) One LCT hard was constructed on Yellow beach at Anzio Port capable of handling six LCTs at a time.
- (b) One LCT hard was constructed on Red beach South of Nettuno capable of handling three LCTs.
- (c) The small craft harbor at Anzio was cleared of sunken ships and debris and put into use.
- (d) Bulldozers operated continuously at ASPs and Gasoline dumps constructing bunker protection.
- (e) Road maintenance on all main and secondary roads in vicinity of Anzio beachhead was continuous all during the month.
- (f) Harbor soundings were made and recorded on map for harbor of Anzio.
- (g) Construction of 5th Army CP at Anzio completed.
- (h) Bunker was constructed for all Dubois of 52nd QM Btn.
- (i) Revetments and digging in of 16th Evac Hospital was accomplished.
- (j) Construction of Incinerator for Anzio was completed.
- (k) Red Cross markers were constructed in Hospital area.
- (l) Civilian Ice-plant repaired and set up for operation in Anzio area.
- (m) Ice making machine constructed and put in operation at Hospital area.
- (n) Revetments constructed at 5205 QM.
- (o) Revetments constructed at 112 Ordnance for Ordnance equipment.
- (p) Underground survey of sewer lines, water mains, and conduits of town of Anzio was made and report submitted.
- (q) Ice making machine assembled, installed, and serviced for Ration dump.
- (r) Approximate one-hundred gallons of water was distilled for CWS daily.
- (s) Stockade constructed for PW, eight-thousand man capacity.
- (t) Made roads, ditches, and revetted tents for installation of 16th Evac Hospital.
- (u) Minefield at Littoria cleared of 580 Italian box-mines and 230 Hol/S mines.
- (v) 3,154 cu. yards of "Black Top" crushed, mixed, and placed on road surface of beachhead.
- (w) Operated 5th Army water point and issued 373,992 gallons of water for the month.
