NOV. 1 - 5, 1944

MIRECOURT, FRANCE. Usual Regimental Personnel Section duties, personnel correspondence and processing daily morning reports G-1 reports and daily ration strength. Officer's pay vouchers for month of October paid. Submitted report on G erman speaking personnel of regiment to Hos. Seventh Army. This Unit consisting of H. & S. Co. 2 Dets' 1st and 2nd Bns. and the six line companies A, B, G, D, E, and F, and the Medical Detachment this Regiment are transferred from the command of NATOUSA to ETCUSA, per Letter Ho. 7th Army, dated 29 October 1944, Subject: Transfer of NATOUSA Personnel that are physically in France as of COOLA hours 1 November 1944

Nov. 6 - 11, 1944

PURECCURE, FRANCE. Usual Regimental Personnel Section duties, personnel correspondence and processing daily morning reports and daily ration strength. Reading of the Articles of War and Sex Morality course entered on 3/R'3. Called in sick B ooks of Regiment for periodic check. Prepared new instructions for submission of PTAs'. Received October Payroll from Finance Office to pay troops. Submitted report on unfilled "Rotation Vacancies" to Hgs 7th Army.

Nov. 12 - 18, 1944

MIRECCURT, FRANCE. Usual Regimental Personnel Section duties, personnel correspondence and processing daily morning reports G-1 reports and daily ration strength. Prepared Officer's Pay Vouchers, obtained signatures and submitted to Finance Office. Processed FTAs. Enlisted Men's payroll prepared, Signatures obtained and submitted to Finance Office. To conform with current instructions, a Personnel Requisition of Hos pitalized Personnel was submitted to Hqs Seventh Army to effect their return.

Nov. 19 - 23, 1944

MIRECCURT, FRANCE. Usual Regimental Personnel Section duties, personnel correspondence and processing daily morning reports, G-1 reports and daily ration strength. Captain T.F.Clifford appointed Class "A" Agent of Major O.C. Culbreth, FD 26th Finance Disbursing Section. Rotation Replacements received for 3/5gt H.M. Dudley, Cpl Gene Miller, and Tec 5 Daniel DiNenna. Its Finnegan and Hudson promoted to Captains per 5/0 233, Hos 7th Army, dated 16 November 1944. Personnel Section moved to new location at Gerbeviller, France.

Mov. 24 - 30, 1944

GERBEVILLER, FRANCE. Usual Regimental Fersonnel Section duties personnel correspondence and daily ration strength processed, Submitted Requisition to H c. 7th Army, for 3° Em to cover losses during coming operations. Submitted report to AG 7th Army on 5Em of Co. "F" and 3 Em of Co. "A" missing when Boat sank during training operations of Regiment. Final Statement prepared on above Em and submitted to Finance Office. 3° Replacements received on Requisition, and assigned them to the various Companies. Issued new FTA instructions. Prepared invertory of effects of 2 missing Em and shipped boxes to Effects Quartermester. Enlisted Pen's payroll and Officer's pay Vouchers for month of November paid.
