ACTIVITY JOURNAL NOVEMBER 1943

- Nov. 1 - 10, 1943 - NAPLES, ITALY : Usual regimental personnel section duties, personnel correspondence, preparing and processing daily morning reports, G-1 daily and weekly reports, daily ration report. Officers' October, 1943 Payroll Vouchers totalling approximately \$4,900.00 paid. Enlisted Men's Supplemental Payroll, including miscellaneous full-pay and partial pay vouchers completed, totalling \$558.00 and payment effected. Processed personnel applications for transmittal of funds by PTA plan. Total amount of PTA applications processed approximately \$18,000.00. Battle Casualty Reports prepared (personnel records processed where necessary) listing 1 EM killed in action; 1 EM died of wounds received in action; and 2 EM as slightly wounded in action (See CASUALTY ANNEX NO. 1).
- Nov. 11 - 19, 1943 - NAPLES, ITALY : Usual regimental personnel section duties, personnel correspondence, preparing and processing daily morning reports, G-1 daily and weekly reports and daily ration report. Enlisted Men's payroll and Officers' Pay Vouchers for month of November, 1943 prepared, signatures obtained and submitted to 6th Port Finance Officer. 1st Lt. Frederick C. Woods, 591st Engineer Boat Regiment transferred to and joined this headquarters and was assigned to Company "C" (18 November 1943). Arrangements completed with Peninsular Base Section for regimental PX supplies for 2-week period. PX supplies distributed and accounting therefor maintained.
- Nov. 20 - VICINITY OF FRANCOLISE, ITALY : Personnel Section, together with other elements of headquarters moved from Naples, Italy, to vicinity of Francolise, Italy. Personnel Section tent headquarters set up.
- Nov. 21 - 25, 1943 - VICINITY OF FRANCOLISE, ITALY : Usual regimental personnel section duties. Lt. Col. William F. Pee assigned and joined from Headquarters Fifth Army (22 Nov. 1943). Battle Casualty Reports submitted listing 2 EM seriously wounded in action; 1 EM slightly wounded in action; 1 EM slightly injured in action; and 1 EM casualty returned to duty (See CASUALTY ANNEX NO. 1)
- Nov. 26 - 30, 1943 - VICINITY OF FRANCOLISE, ITALY : Usual regimental personnel section duties: personnel correspondence, preparing and processing daily morning reports, G-1 daily and weekly reports, daily ration report also maintenance of PX accounting. Battle Casualty Reports prepared and submitted listing 2 EM casualties returned to duty (See CASUALTY ANNEX NO. 1).
