- To : Commanding Coneral, SEVENTH ARMY, APO 758, US Army.
- 1. Following is a condensation of ACTIVITY JOURNAL, this Headquarters, for the menth of September, 1944:
- 1 Sep 9 Sep 1944 PORT OF ST. RAPHAEL, FRANCE. Centimed Army Pert Command and supervision of Pert and Red Boach operations, supply dumps and railroad leading (CAMEL BEAGE). Operation of Pert of St. Rephael being assumed by 3524 Pert Bn. under 6th Pert Headquarters toward ond of period. Elements of Regiment engaged in bridge construction (CANNES) and construction started on 2-way, Glass 49, vehicular traffic read over existing damaged railway bridge at LYON. Engaged in extensive read and street clearance and maintenance program (BOURG-LYON-VILLARS), including construction and maintenance of read culverts. Regulating traffic on Bailey bridge at LYON and operated water paints at ST. RAPHAEL AND LYON.

BOURS, FRANCE. Administration, supervision and coordination of Regimental Units engaged in bridge construction (Bailey railread bridge, FONT B'AIN), bridge reinforcements, and maintenance of Bailey Bridge at LYON; read clearance, maintenance and repairs (LYON-AMBOIS), including construction of culverts; eperation of water points; inventory of enemy dump at VALDAHON; Army Engineer Truck transportation details.

26 Sep - 30 Sep 1944 - GRAY, FRANCE. Second Battalien engaged in special training program (heavy penten, support and penten rafts); centinued railread bridge reinfercement and construction, PONT B'AIN; continued construction of treatle bridge ever the DOUDS River at BAHMES-LES-DAMES; clearing and maintaining reads, IONGEAU-ORVILLE DIJON; centimed recennaissance of reads and railway line; eperation of water points; furnished truck transportation details at request of Army Engineer.
