During the month this Section requisitioned and issued to the Regiment two (2) suits of woolen underwear, one (1) overcoat or mackinaw per man and one (1) additional blanket per Officer and Man.

All Tentage, Truck and Trailer Tarpaulins, Combat Jackets, Shoes and Combat Boots in the Regiment in need of repair and not salvageable were taken up and repaired and returned to the respective organizations.

Water Points were set up and operated in Amance, Dole, Gray, Bayon, Mirecourt, 21st General Hospital in Ravinel and Chatenois and a total of 831,415 gallons of water dispensed.

All necessary Rations, Gasoline, Diesel Oil, Lubrication Oil and Grease was requisitioned and issued to the Companies. All Salvage Clothing and equipment was teken in and about 95% replacement was received and returned to companies.

The following Major items of equipment shortages were requisitioned, received and issued to the respective organizations.

A detail from S-4 spent fourteen (14) days in St Etienne, St Chamond, St Jost, Villeurbanne, Terrenoir, Dijons and Lyon purchasing construction material for bridges and roads which had been assigned to the Regiment to build and repair and to procure Electrical and Plumbing Supplies to complete construction of the French Hospital at Ravinel, requisitioned and occupied by the 21st General Hospital.
