The campaign of Naples-Foggia 9 september 1943 to 21 January 1944, and the campaign of Rome- Arno 22 January 1944 to 12 March 1944 when he was wounded at Anzio.He received the Bronze star medal, The Purple Heart, the European-African-Middle eastern Theater Medal with four campaign stars.Good conduct medal,American campaign medal and World War 11 Victory Medal. He also was awarded the New York State Conspicuous Service Medal. He lost his leg and spent about a year in Walter Reed and other hospitals before receiving a Certificate of Disability on 30 January 1945 and sent home. There was a local parade in his honor. My Grandmother had four other sons that served during world war two. Two more sons in the Army, one in the Navy and one in the Merchant Marines. 
