

I got out of famp Forrest about 0800 yesterlag and got back to this camp about 1400 ochocks. We c had a rather rough ride in the truck from forrest to here but what the heck I got back. Lefter getting here the CO was out in the field so I had to sit around , wait for him . He gat back about 515 and suported in ite & then ato and then I went to town with factotta + author guy. Scanthone was in town already. I intended to write you from the E. 4 so in town but you know how It is, I got to drinking with the bays o putting off writing until it was too late so I came back to famp + went to bed. I am sorry sweet but I know you will forgive me this time. Now sweet I have some news for you again. First I cought a little cold the four

at the W CAMP FORREST days Sepent in Forest coming back. I treat very bad & I think I will get once it very quickly fan you imagine though, sleeping all winter in the cold+ wet + then when I sleepin a warm borracks 4 mites I catch cold. The other news, while I was gone the Browns given beday furloughs to about 20% of the near my name Iwas on the list and not being here someone else gat my place. I felt bad about it of course but the I looked at lit this way, if I took a leday forlough now, when neget to comp + get our 15 day fuloughs I would only leave 9 days left. This way asher we get our good furlough I can take it all at once. I asked for a 3 kay pass inasmuch is I lost out on the fulough, but don't know yet whether I will got it or not. Keep your fingers crossed dear & soon as I learn anything definite I will let you know. now comes the other news, I don't know whithis it is good or bad any way here it is. Dan going to be taken out of the line platoor



and put in headquarters platoon and now comes the longh. I am going to be mess sergeout. year I know it sounded furny to me too but The 90 ask me to take it to I said I would try. I told them I didn't know any thing about it but was teld that it wouldn't take long to catche on. I don't have to wohow anything like that, just take charged the kitchen, see that theirs are kept night relian , keep the cooks on the ball, he that meals are ready on time and make out the menus.
