The records show that on 17 March 1945, Technician Chandler was operating a crane on the Ludendorf Bridge in Remagen, Germany. The bridge collapsed without warming and when his whereabouts could not be ascertained he was reported missing as of that date. In a further message based on a burial report received by his organization, Technician Chandler was reported to have died on 17 March 1945. However, a still later report has been submitted which discloses that his death was the result of enemy action. You have my assurance that in the event additional information concerning Technician Chandler's death is forthcoming, his family will be notified without delay.

Your interest in behalf of Mr. Chandler is most considerate and he has my deep sympathy in the loss of his beloved son.






