THE SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR

Order for Taking Possession:

By virtue of the authority vested in me by the President of the United States, I hereby find from the available information that a strike or stoppage has occurred or is threatened in each of the coal mines operated by the componies specified in Appendix A attached hereto, and therefore take possession of each such mine including any and all real and personal property, franchises, rights, facilities, funds, and other assets used in connection with the operation of such mine and the distribution and sale of its products, for operation by the United States in furtherance of the prosecution of the war.

The president of each company (or its chief executive officer) specified in Appendix A attached hawter, is hereby and until further entire designated Operating Manager for the United States for such more and is outherland and directed, subject to such experience on I may prescribe, and in accordance with regulations to be promulgated by me, to operate

such ming and to do all things necessary and appropriate for the operation of the mine, and for the distribution and sole of the product thereof.

All of the officers and employees of the company are serving the Government of the United States and shall present furthers to perform their usual functions and duties in connection with the operation of the mine and the distribution and sale of the product thereof, and shall conduct themselves with full regard for their obligation to the Government of the United States.


No person shall interfere with the operation of the more by the United States Government, or the sole or distribution of the product thereof, in accordance with this profes.

The Operating Manager for the United States shall furthership the flog of the United States upon the mining premises, post in a compression place upon the premises an which such mine is located a notice of taking prosession of the mine by the Secretary of the Interior, and furnish a copy of such notice to all persons in prosession of funds and propenter due and every to the company.

Processor and operation of any mine may be terminated by the Secretary of the baterior of such time as he should find that such possestion and operation are no longer required for the successful procession of the way.




